## Chatham Retired Educators Association Minutes, March 11, 2024

Call to Order and Welcome: President C. Howard called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.

Adoption of Agenda: The appropriate motions were made and the agenda was adopted with flexibility.

Pledge of Allegiance: The members recited "The Pledge of Allegiance".

Inspiration & Invocation: Mrs. R. Jackson gave the Invocation and Inspiration.

**Presentation & Approval of Minutes:** Ms. Moyer presented the February 12, 2024, Minutes. The appropriate motions were made and the February Minutes were accepted.

**Reading of Correspondence:** Mrs. P. Simmons reported that the Georgia Retired Educators Foundation, Inc., wants each unit to donate \$100 so that GREF can award 25 \$1000 scholarships to teachers. GREF will also have a silent auction to raise money. Mrs. Howard asked the members what action they wanted to take. It was decided to wait until after the Treasurer's report. \* Savannah Schools Federal Credit Union will meet on March 19, 5:30 P.M., Johnson High, to celebrate 70 years. \* Mrs. P. Simmons read a thank you card from the family of Mrs. Sula Hall. \* CREA may buy a plate for the Georgia Retired Educators Museum.

**Financial Report:** Mrs. Ellis reported that as of February 29, 2024, the checkbook, ledger, and bank each have a balance of \$7309.08. The report was received as information and filed for audit. Mrs. Howard informed us that the money left over from the caterer bought this morning's breakfast items. Mrs. D. Wilson asked whether the GREF donation could come from our contingency fund. Mrs. Ellis said there is enough money. Dr. Baker moved that CREA use \$100 from the contingency fund for the GREF, Incorporated, donation. Mrs. A Mitchell made the second, and the members voted unanimously to do this.

March Birthday Celebration: Mrs. Caughman recognized members who have March birthdays. The members sang Stevie Wonder's rendition of "Happy Birthday".

**President's Report (Emailed):** Mrs. C. Howard attended the 50<sup>th</sup> Wedding Anniversary celebration for Rev. Chester and Mrs. Wilmotine Ellis. They are members, a past president, and current treasurer. Mrs. Howard attended the presentation celebration of Eddie Lee Marsh as National President of Top Ladies of Distinction, Inc. Mrs. Howard participated in Election Training for the upcoming Presidential Election. She mentored students at Groves High and at the STEM Academy, recruited new members, e-mailed CREA reminders to members, prepared the agenda for the March meeting, and emailed letters of invitation to newly retired educators. Mrs. Howard participated in Executive Board Meetings of National Council of Negro Women, Area IV Top Ladies of Distinction, Inc., Dr. M. L. King Observance Day Association, and the Baroness Club.

**Area Director's Report:** Mrs. A. Mitchell reported for Dr. Cooper. She reminded us that all reports are due April 1, 2024. She asked us to please attend the May convention. She informed us that we did not reach the 7% increase in GREA membership, and so we did not obtain Unit of Distinction.

**Program:** President Elect Simmons introduced our first speaker, Mrs. Cathy Mendelsohn, who spoke to us on how to outsmart scammers. She is in the Georgia Attorney General's Office in the Consumer Protection Division. She discussed information about scams and also gave us a book, The Georgia Consumer Protection Guide for Older Adults.

Our second speaker was Ms. Lisa McKenzie with AMBA. She discussed various benefits and gave us a handout with additional information. Ms. McKenzie also reminded us that we may recruit people who did not work in a school system to be GREA Associate Members. They count toward the goal of a 7% increase in GREA membership.

**Membership**, **Local**: Ms. A. Smith reported two new members, Deborah Moore and Dr. Thomas Williams. Ms. Smith thanked us for all we do to help.

**Membership, State:** Mrs. Platts reported that we have a total of 33 new GREA members, but we did not reach our goal. She thanked us for recruiting. She also recognized several more Emeritus members.

Necrology: The members observed a moment of silence while Mr. Howard read the names of those who passed.

**Newsletter & Public Relations:** Dr. B. Roberts reported she emailed CREA Connections Newsletter to members and mailed them to members without email, submitted an article to the *Savannah Tribune*, submitted pictures to GREA's Facebook page, and updated CREA's Face Book page.

**Webmaster's Report:** The CREA website has been updated with information concerning the March meeting. Pages for January and February, 2024, have been created. Dr. Baker thanked Dr. Roberts. There is a link to registration forms for the convention and hotels on the website. Also, there is a list of restaurants in Athens.

Spotlight Ads: We have raised \$800. Those who donated will receive a special appreciation gift at the next meeting.

With the appropriate motions, the floor was closed to additional nominations. Mrs. DeLoach made the motion and Mrs. Singleton made the second to accept the slate of officers for the 2024-25 year.
